

THEE L.W. Higgins Dress Code Policy

NO ALTERING of the UNIFORM IN ANY WAY. – Ex. tying, pinning, sewing, etc.

1) Shirts

- a) Only seniors are permitted to wear button-up Oxfords.**
- b) All students must wear the L.W. Higgins uniform shirt assigned to their grade level.
Below is a list of the colors assigned to each grade:
 - i) Freshmen (9th Graders) – Grey
 - ii) Sophomores (10th Graders) – Blue
 - iii) Juniors (11th Graders) – White
 - iv) Seniors (12th Graders) – Gold or button-up oxfords
- c) Students may not change their assigned uniform color (shirts) at any time, and promotions will only be granted at the end of the school year.
- d) Spirit shirts, class shirts, or sports shirts can be worn every Friday. Shirts with hoods are not permitted. Uniform pants must be worn (**NO WARM-UP PANTS**).
- e) Shirts are to be worn tucked into pants. Shirts must be long enough to tuck into clothing and not come out while the student is on campus.
- f) T-shirts can be worn under uniform shirts.
- g) Shirts can be no more than one size larger or smaller than the student's measured size. Students must wear properly fitted shirts that are true to their required size.

2) Pants

- a) Only khaki Dickies, or school colored plaid pants can be worn. This applies to both male and female students.**
- b) Students are **Not Allowed** to wear the following:
 - c) Tights, leggings, or yoga pants
 - d) Ankle pants
 - e) Cargo pants
 - f) Pants with an elastic ankle
 - g) Skinny leg pants
 - h) Pants with cell phone pockets
 - i) Jeans/No ripped jeans are allowed during “dress down” days
 - j) Pants must be worn at the waist and secured with a belt.

3) Shorts

- a) Only khaki shorts, or school colored plaid shorts can be worn. Only shorts that reach the knee are permitted. This applies to both male and female students.**

4) Skirts

- a) No skirts are allowed to be worn at school**

5) Shoes

- a) Shoes must be **enclosed loafers, oxfords, or tennis shoes**. Shoes made for strings must have strings and be tied. **Only ankle-length or mid-thigh-length boots are permitted.**
- b) Socks or stockings must be worn with shoes
- c) **NO** fishnet stocking, slippers, backless shoes, flip-flops, potato shoes, crocs, high-tops, ballerina, baby doll, etc.
- d) Students are **NOT PERMITTED** to wear slippers during “dress down” days.

6) Jackets/Sweatshirts/Hoodies/Zipper Fronts

- a) Students can **ONLY** wear an approved jacket or sweatshirt with the L. W. Higgins Logo
- b) **No other jackets or sweatshirts will be allowed on campus.**
- c) All jackets must have a zipper front. The zipper must run the entire length of the jacket. Shirts cannot be worn as jackets.
- d) Jackets must be hemmed and no shorter than the waist.
- e) Jackets must be long-sleeved

7) Head Coverings

- a) **Students must remove their nightcaps, shower caps, bonnets, and hair scarves before entering campus.**
- b) Knit caps in cold weather are permitted outside only
- c) No other head coverings are permitted – **NO BALL CAPS**, “doo” rags
- d) No rollers or flexi rods

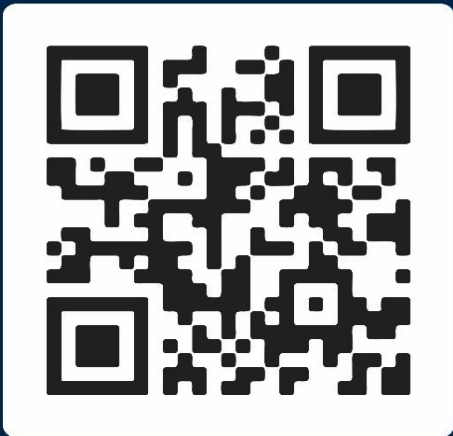
